Project Impact guidance



As Innovate UK is a public body it's natural that there is increasing scrutiny of our investments. The government expects, and the public deserves, visibility on how this money is being spent. We want to show the impact that Innovate UK investments are having for our innovative companies, and most importantly how they are helping to achieve our national goals.

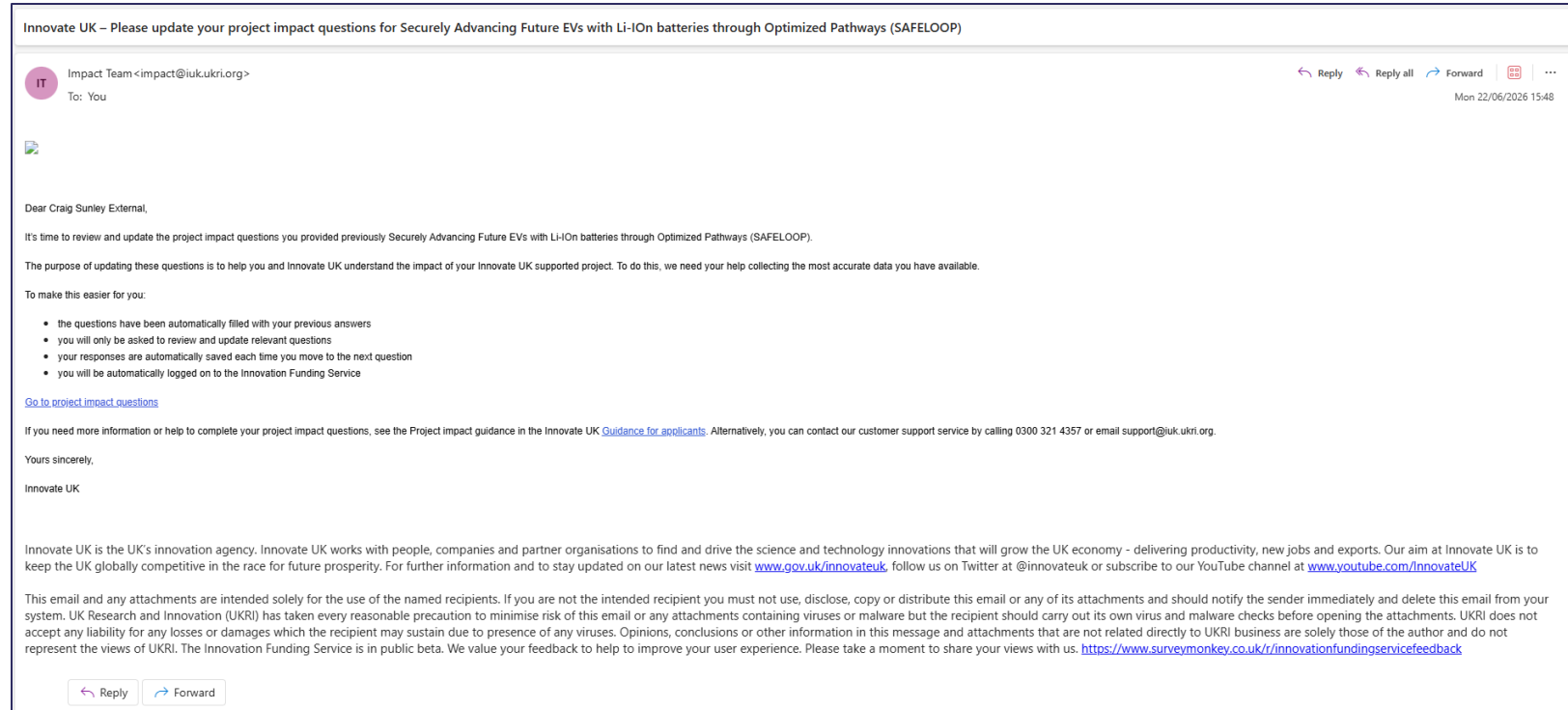
To help quantify these impacts Innovate UK has launched the Impact Management Framework, with the aim of collecting data annually from our applicants and funded partners via the 'Project Impact' questions.

Project Impact is required by all applicants and project partners:

- It is an online form with questions about your organisation and the impact of your project
- We request the form be updated annually from your project start date, at project closure and annually for five years post project closure

Accessing your Project Impact questions

- An email will be sent to your Finance Contact or Project Manager. If at the end of your project, this will be the day after your Project End date.
- Contact impact@iuk.ukri.org if you haven't received this email.
- Click the link to access your Project Impact questions, this link is unique to your organisation on your project.
- The link can be shared with others in your organisation.



Accessing your Project Impact questions

- You must have an Innovation Funding Service account to access your Project Impact questions.
- Login using your email address and password.
- If you have forgotten your login details, contact support@iuk.ukri.org
- If you receive an error message after logging in contact impact@iuk.ukri.org

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Completing your Project Impact questions

- The introduction pages includes additional information and guidance about the Project Impact questions.
- Go to the bottom of the page to see a list of questions you will be asked to complete.
- Click Continue to start updating your Project Impact questions.

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Application overview

Project impact questions

You will be asked to complete a series of questions which are tailored to this specific Innovate UK Support (information support and funding). If you are completing this after the application stage, you will see your previous answers for you to review and update.

When completing these questions, your responses are automatically saved each time you move to the next question. Once you have completed all the questions, a summary page will allow you to review, edit and submit your responses.

Each organisation in your project must complete all the questions, via their own project impact form. Many of the questions are not required for public sector organisations, research technology organisations, academic institutes, Catapults, or individuals; if this is the case, please select 'Not Applicable' where relevant.

You will be asked to review and update these questions throughout, and after your project. This is to enable you and Innovate UK to monitor the impact of your project. Your previous answers will be saved and presented back to you each time, to make it easier for you.

Completing your Project Impact questions

- Each question includes detailed help text to support you to provide accurate information.
- Please provide the most accurate information you have available to you.
- Many of the questions ask you to record impact in your organisation, that are due to the project and realised in the previous 12 months. If there has been no impact, it is ok to answer 0.
- Many of the financial questions are not relevant to universities and non-businesses, these can be skipped by entering 'Not applicable'.
- Click Continue to go to the next question.

Private funding as a result of this support

As a result of this Innovate UK support, estimate the total value of any private funding you have received in the last 12 months?

Review and update your previous answer (if applicable). Complete for the last 12 months. If this information is not available, your answer may cover your nearest full financial year.

Private funding is funding received by your business/organisation from external, private sector sources. External private sector finance in the business could include: bank debt or loans, bonds, equity finance – venture capital funds or business angels, corporate venture finance, friends or family.

This should include investment in Research and Development (R&D) or in the business more broadly. As a result of this Innovate UK support, refers to this business support or funded project, only include what you can attribute to this Innovate UK support or project.

We only require an estimate because we understand that an exact number could be difficult to obtain. Only include what you can attribute to this Innovate UK support. Exclude any aligned investment received as part of an innovate UK Investor partnership programme.

Enter your answer in whole pounds (£), rounded to the nearest thousand. For example, if your answer is £22,800, round it up to £23,000 and enter it as '23000'.

Your answer will help us understand to what extent Innovate UK support unlocks private investment.
